2025 Membership Application

The Member hereby agrees to pay Sandy Hook Bay Catamaran Club (SHBCC) the sum equal to their 2025 rate schedule in return for assigned summer storage of their boat/sail box/tube and all other applicable membership fees.

Said rate shall be secured by means of payment in full upon signing of this agreement. Storage shall begin on or about April 1 and terminate on or about November 5 and an additional fee will be applied to those who do not pay the winter storage fee by December 15th of that year. All equipment left on the premises after said date shall be subject to applicable winter storage rates.

Charges will include launching privileges for all boats and sailboards, stored or trailered in to the beach area, but such privileges are not applicable to powerboats. Similarly, storage of sail boxes/tubes without boats shall be \$30.00 per season.

There will be no refunds - Beach spots are transferable only for the remainder of the year.

The Skipper, Crew, or Social Member agree that they, and their guests, invitees, etc., shall at all times be subject to (1) The By-Laws of SHBCC as the same may exist from time to time and (2) Any and all rules, regulations, and policies established from time to time by the Board of Directors and Officers of SHBCC. Among such rules and regulations and policies as examples only are; the right to temporarily move stored boats, trailers and relocate equipment to facilitate club sanctioned activities; parking regulations; rules regarding garbage disposal; prohibition of glass on the beach; prohibition of motor vehicles on the beach, etc...

No outside contractors shall be permitted to work on the premises without the express consent of SHBCC, although SHBCC does hereby agree to permit the Member to service his or her own equipment as necessary, provided that SHBCC shall be held harmless from any claims resulting from damage or injury to any person caused in any way by, or through such activity. It shall be the obligation of the Member to secure his or her own equipment. SHBCC agrees to use reasonable measures to prevent loss or damage. However; the Member acknowledges that SHBCC is not insured and that it shall not be held responsible for any loss, liability, or damage which may arise as a result of fire, theft, flood, vandalism or any other condition beyond its reasonable control. The Member shall also be responsible for any damage caused by his/her equipment to other equipment or property on SHBCC premises. It is strongly recommended that all boat owners secure liability and property insurance.

The named applicant, non-member and their crew, guests, or invitees, shall hold SANDY HOOK BAY CATAMARAN CLUB INC., harmless from any BODILY INJURY and all claims, actions, damages or liability ARISING out of, while practicing for, or participating in any activities, contest, or exhibition of and sponsored by SHBCC including, but not limited to SAILBOAT RACING.

Safety & Security Beach Rules

1. Boats stored on trailers must be tied down by 4 pylons to the trailers.
2. Boats on the beach *must* have 2 or more secure tie-downs.
3. Do not leave wheels at the waters edge after use. Return them to inside the gate next to the bulletin board. (We've lost wheels during tide changes.)
4. Boats with sails up, on wheels are not to be moved above the high water line. This rule is for personal and club wheels.
Notice of addition to Rule #5. A fine of \$25.00 can be imposed by the wheel captain for members who bring their boats on wheels, with sails up, above the high tide line. Moving boats with sails up, on wheels is dangerous! Also it can destroy wheel bearings in fleet wheels. Non-payment of fine will be carried to the next season and if not paid during sign-up period will constitute forfeit of previous seasons boat spot.
5. Do not put your boat, or trailer, in any spot other than your assigned spot.
6. Do not leave boats on wheels, others are waiting for them.
7. When in storage, all wings must be up, except 21's.
8. Drive slowly in the parking and fenced in areas. Speed limit is 5 mph. Be safe!
9. All garbage must be separated and sorted into the proper receptacles.
10. No glass is to be used on the beach.
11. Pick up after your dog.
12. Step your mast in the rear of the parking lot or the outside soccer field parking lot.
13. Cars and trailers are not permitted on the sand beach. Use wheels to move boats from the parking lot to the beach spot. Do not block any beach gates.
14. The cathouse and shed are to be used for storage of fleet owned equipment & fleet supplies, only. No personal items.
15. A guest that visits the beach more than 3 times is expected to join. Do not expect the club to subsidize your guests indefinitely.
16. Anyone under 21, is not allowed to consume alcoholic beverages, under any circumstances.
17. Beach hours- March, 9 AM to 5 PM only on weekends
April thru November, Dawn to Dusk
18. Boats, trailers or other personal property not actively registered to the SHBCC, on SHBCC premisses and lacking club payment will become club property or sold in lew of payment .
19. On weekends and holidays there is no parking in the area between the cathouse and the bulletin board. (No vehicle is to be left in the main area unattended.)
20. Washing cars is not permitted at the club.
21. Flying of drones on or over any club premisses is not permitted without prior permission from SHBCC Officers.
22. NO FIREWORKS ALLOWED ON PROPERTY
22. No open fires allowed anywhere on club property.
